Principals Scholarship (1)

This Scholarship will be awarded to a student entering Year 7 to Year 11 in 2025 who has demonstrated outstanding performance in at least one non-academic field, such as music, performing arts or sports. This may be evidenced by inclusion in a State squad/team, or, for example, several awards for excellence in a particular field. The successful applicant will be expected to work hard and show leadership throughout their active involvement in their non-academic field.

- Awarded to a current Year 6 10 student entering Year 7 11 2025
- Provides 100% remission of tuition fees at SJAS through to Year 12
- Applications due by Sunday 28 April 2024, 12.00pm (AWST)

The Allan Griffiths Leadership Scholarship (1)

This scholarship is named in honour of Mr Allan Griffiths, first Chair of School Council of St James' Anglican School, who contributed significantly to SJAS. Mr Griffiths is also currently Vice Chair of St James' Anglican School Council.

- Awarded to a Year 9 student entering Year 10 2025
- Provides 50% remission of tuition fees at SJAS for Year 10 through to Year 12
- Applications due by Sunday 28 April 2024, 12.00pm (AWST)

Indigenous Scholarships (1)

The School Council has endorsed with enthusiasm the formation of an Indigenous Scholarship program for students currently in Year 6-11, that will enable students to enrol at the School and experience the full range of opportunities that an SJAS education can provide.

The Scholarships will provide the following support:

- 100% of the tuition costs and
- The cost of any compulsory School Camps
- Applications due by Sunday 28 April 2024, 12.00pm (AWST)
- All other costs must be met by the successful candidate's parents/guardians.



SELECTION PROCESS

Candidates are selected for Scholarships at the discretion of the Principal and after considering the following factors:

- School Reports/Academic Assessments (NAPLAN/OLNA)
- Scholarship Application
- Interview

CONDITIONS OF AWARDS

- These Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Principal by recommendation from the Scholarship Committee. Successful candidates must demonstrate a sound academic record together with the potential to make a positive contribution to the School.
- The Scholarships are awarded on the condition that the recipient will finish their secondary education at SJAS. Should a Scholarship recipient leave the School prior to graduation they may be required to return the financial award of the Scholarship to the School.
- The continuation of the Scholarship throughout the year is subject to the recipient making good academic progress, displaying conduct of the highest standard and contributing to the life of the School through participation in leadership and other co-curricular activities.
- The school reserves the right to not award Scholarships if there are no suitable applicants, as determined by the Scholarship Committee.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Academic, The Allan Griffiths Leadership and Indigenous Scholarships

The attached application form should be completed and returned to the School together with:

- A copy of the student's latest school report
- A copy of the student's latest NAPLAN results
- Evidence to support application (Principal's Scholarship)
- A recent character reference from an adult who knows the applicant well but is not their current education provider or related to the applicant
- Proof of Aboriginality (Indigenous Scholarship)

Interviews

Shortlisted applicants will be contacted to attend an interview with the Principal. Parents will have the opportunity to tour the School facilities and meet with Senior School staff and student leaders during the student interview.
