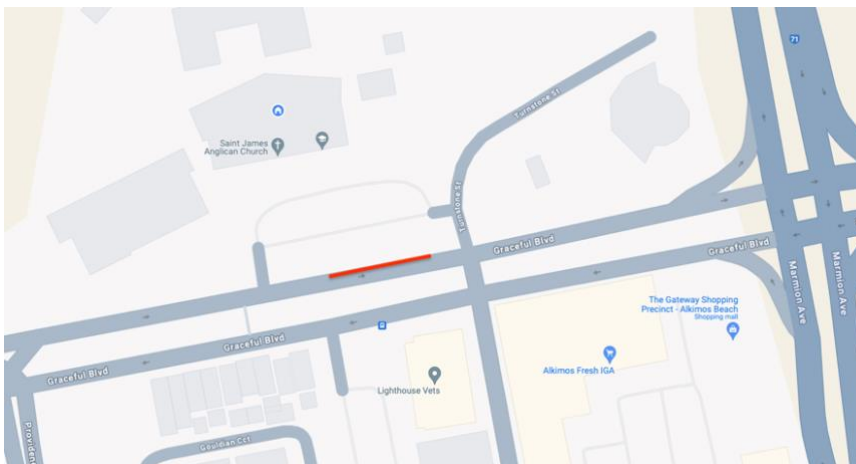
SCHOOL FEE PAYMENTS
